3. Objective(s): To assist the participants (Bicycle Riders) of the 2022 Regalado Road Race. This is a bicycle race however, the course is not closed and there could be traffic on the road. All stations should be on post no later than 0745 hrs. The first heat takes off at 0800. For further information regarding the event please refer to the attached flyer. The event concludes at approximately 1200-1300 hours. SARA Club amateur radio operators will assist with net control and fixed post support. Their role is amateur radio communications to assist in the safe operation of this ride. Watch for safety violations along the route and attempt to mitigate them or call for assistance. Assist injured riders. Assist disabled riders.				
4. Operational Period Command Emphasis: Establish Net Control Station <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Make announcement that the SARA High Level VHF repeater is in use for the controlled net Make sure all locations are staffed 				
General Situational Awareness: Watch for safety violations. Watch for overhead hazards such as power lines and tree branches. Be aware of traffic (both vehicle and bicyclists) on the roadways at all times. Stay hydrated. Have and drink plenty of water and have snacks and a lunch. If working a fixed post you may want to have a chair available as well. Have sunscreen available. Dress appropriate for conditions and have rain gear available. ACCUWeather forecast: Sunday June 5, 2022 weather prediction (as of June 2, 2022). Plenty of morning clouds, then times of sun and clouds in the afternoon. High 82, Low 58, 25% chance of rain, Winds NNW 12 mph with gusts of 23mph, UV index 9(very high). **Please read the COVID 19 Mitigations listed on Page 6 of the IAP.** There will be on site first aid personnel at the start line near net control. If a radio operator needs first aid personnel to respond call Net Control and they will send medical staff to the requested area. Please try to provide the following information: 1. Chief complaint and incident type (what happened, how are they hurt?) • Is there more than one person injured? 2. Approximate age of the patient(s)? 3. Conscious: Yes/No...or alert? 4. Breathing: Yes/No...or difficulty? 5. Is there chest pain? 6. Accident or illness case: Is there severe bleeding? (spurting/pouring?)

Registration: Each Category registers 6:30 a.m. to 15 minutes before scheduled start.

Directions: Take Hwy 120 to and east through Oakdale, and turn right on Wamble Road (after Orange Blossom Rd) east of town and then follow the signs to registration and parking, at Burchell Nursery, at 9310 Wamble Road, Oakdale, CA 95361, just south of Hwy 120/108

Course: This is a 17-mile loop course in Stanislaus County. The race promenades (all riders) from the Nursery driveway, starts at the Emery/Warnerville corner and finishes on Warnerville Road east of Emery, south of registration/parking, Loop: heads west on Warnerville, south on Stoddard, east on Alvarado, south on Ellenwood, east on Claribel, north on Tim Bell, and west on Warnerville back to the finish hill, just east of Emery). Feed zone is on Warnerville 100 meters east of Emery (park on Emery) Neutral water, bottles and feeders available. Pavement is mostly good, with some potholes; the former gravel section has been paved, but has a lot of poorly solidified spots; keep your eyes open in this 1 mile long section on Tim Bell. Several small hills, including the finish climb, two railroad crossings which should not present delays. No gas, services or phones available on the course, but everything is available in Oakdale.

Prizes: will be cash, (50% in larger lists, 0% in \$50 prize lists) and tee shirts; Medals to top three in each of the 5-year categories in the Masters and Master Women's Championship events, and jersey to winner in each. Prizes in each of these races is to the overall top six.

Eligibility ----All races are open to riders from outside the district, prizes are available to all riders, but medals and any other awards are open only to riders from the Northern California/Nevada District, according to their USAC license.

How to Enter:

---via On-line at www.BikeReg.com from today to May 29 for above fees plus on-line surcharge. From May 30-June 1 the fee on-line is \$8 additional. No on-line entry after midnight PST June 1. You can also enter on race day up to 15 minutes before your start, but must do it online (via phone) at <https://bikereg.com/regalado-road-race>

---By Mail: You may still enter by mail, but if a group is filling, go on-line. By mail, send standard USAC entry form/release along with fee above (if Postmarked by Friday May 27 to Velo Promo/Regalado, 19780 Soulsbyville Road, Soulsbyville, CA 95372. For those postmarked after, add \$8. Note: indicate what category you are entering on check or form. Entries for several races in one envelope ok, but be sure to list race names on the outside. Envelopes without names of races on the outside may go to the wrong race. Mail in entries will not be processed until after the opening of online reg.

---At Race: You may enter at the race, only via Bike Reg online (by phone) at <https://bikereg.com/regalado-road-race> provided your event is not filled, for the above listed fee plus \$10. There will **not** be 2nd race groups at this race.

2022 USAC license required (available online at USACycling.org). One day licenses (\$10) are available only for Novice riders. Entry fees include \$1.50 NCNCA and \$5.05 USCF insurance surcharges. Numbers will be provided.

Credits: Credit for another VP race will be given if VP is notified at tech@BikeReg.com by 5 pm PST Thursday 5/27 that you can't compete. No credit issued if you plan to enter another race that day instead; no cash refunds. No substitutions for cancellations. Send e-mail for credit to tech@BikeReg.com.

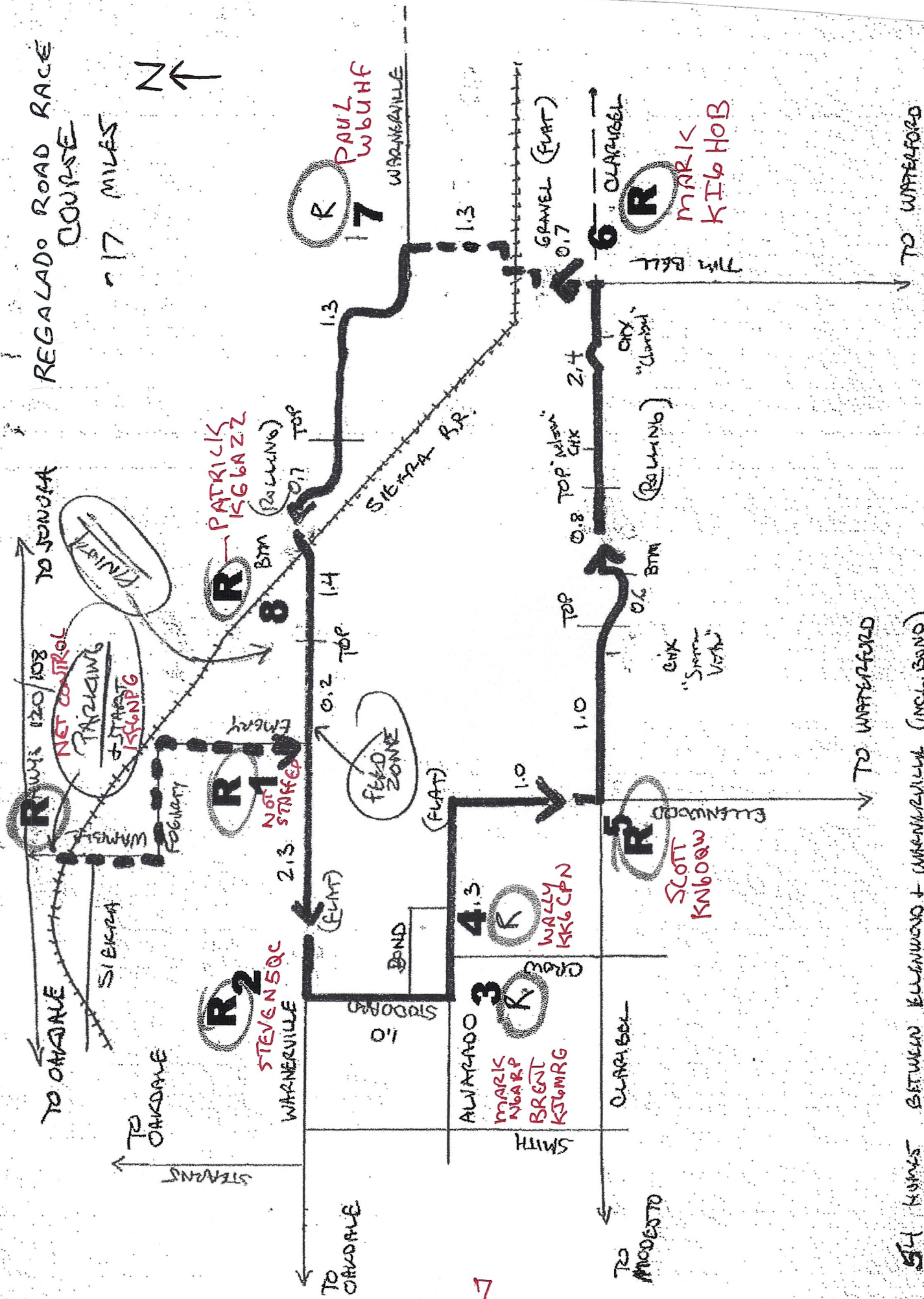
Champion Discounts: Champions pay normal fees up front; Current NorCal/Nevada District Road Race Champions and National Road Champions will get a refund at the reg desk of all but \$5 per day if 1) their entry is received by the deadline above (otherwise they pay full fee, including late fee) and 2) they ride in the category they won the championship in (Master Champions may ride down in age, and ride for \$5, and Juniors may ride up. District jersey is not required

Covid-19 Mitigations: Mitigations mirroring CDC, California and Sanislaus County guidance regarding Covid-19 If you have Covid, have been exposed to it in the past 14 days, or have symptoms of it, don't come. Those not following the mitigations will be asked to correct or leave.

Rules: Please, please use the toilets provided, and be civil to the local residents. They can make it really tough to hold another race here. Official follow vehicles only (any volunteers?) There may be none for your group; be prepared with pump and spare. We may be able to use the whole road for the race; negotiations are currently underway. If not, centerline will be enforced; if you can't stay on your side of the road, stay home.
